## 109S MITCH LOW CABINET

Mitch has a lightweight appearance that belies the robust structure. The low cabinet body is raised on slender brass legs. With open compartments and sliding doors on both the front and back, this cabinet has no backside, making it suitable for use in the centre of a room. Inspired by traditional Venetian doorbells, burnished brass is used for the door pull, for an exciting contrast of materials that nods to the designer's heritage.



### **MATERIALS**

#### TIMBER

Black walnut, white oak, or ash with a choice of a clear Danish oil, white oil, or black oil finish. White oak additionally available oxidised; ash additionally available stained or painted in a choice of 10 colours: black, white, bone, ochre, bordeaux, forest, fjord, bay, lagoon, or cove.

#### PAINTED HDF

Painted HDF in a choice of 10 colours: black, white, bone, ochre, bordeaux, forest, fjord, bay, lagoon, or cove with a satin matte or gloss finish.

#### METAL

Brushed brass legs.

### **NOTES**

One internal storage box in black dyed wood composite with an oil and wax finish. Four sliding doors (two on each side). Burnished brass detailing.
